Our Mission

- To connect people and organizations that use PostgreSQL: individuals, entrepreneurs, small to large enterprises, and government entities.
- To provide high-quality educational sessions about PostgreSQL, from feature explorations to operational guidance, from local and global speakers alike.
- To broaden the conversation between open-source and commercial interests, and provide an environment to help enhance the future development of PostgreSQL.
- To encourage the growth of the PostgreSQL community in the Midwest through learning and networking opportunities with affordable entry prices.

Brief History Of Events

PG DATA is the first event of a new conference series with an emphasis on education, developer community-building, and outreach to academia. In previous years, the organizers have run several events at this scale, including:

- 2023: PGDay Chicago 2023, 1 day, 30+ speakers, 100 attendees
- 2024: PGDay Chicago 2024, 1 day, 20+ speakers, 100+ attendees
- 2025: PGDay Chicago 2025, 1 day, 15 speakers, 100+ attendees plus colocated Student PG
 DATA Day of training, with 4 training sessions and 50 attendees

Why PG DATA 2026?

- Not for profit: run by and for the Midwest PostgreSQL community.

- To connect attendees and sponsors, and continue to build the Midwestern and global Postgres community that we are all a part of.
- To continue to draw diverse audiences of people in the technology field to learn about PostgreSQL:
 - developers, DBAs, system administrators, technology leaders
 - o consultants, students and academics, corporate professionals, entrepreneurs
